PROGRAM AND STAGES

Saturday – welcome

Meeting point at Treviso airport (TSF) or Venice airport (VCE) if you arrive by flight. If you arrive with your car meeting point at the hotel.

Holiday check-in at the hotel, room assignment and breefing with welcome drink. Dinner in hotel.

Sunday – Prosecco Hills

A warm-up day in the UNESCO area of the Prosecco hills.

Departure in early morning from the hotel in the direction of Conegliano, to overcome the "climb of Ca 'del Poggio". Short refreshment and We continue towards some short but intense tears that lead us to ancient villages of historical value located in the heart of the Prosecco hills. A short stretch of ups and downs and in Valdobbiadene we stop for a "panoramic" light lunch. On the way back to the hotel, a tasting of 'bubbles' sparkling wine will allow us to catch our breath and a little energy.

<u>Prosecco</u>

Sparkling wine known all over the world grown between Conegliano, Valdobbiadene and Asolo.

The hills of Prosecco

They were declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2019, not for the wine, but for the geological and landscape conformation.

The particular location and exposure gives the wine qualities of freshness and naturalness.









Monday - Montegrappa, the Italian Mont Ventoux

Let's get serious with a climb worthy of the name. 27K and 1500m in altitude in one breath. Departure from hotel and approach to the slopes of Montegrappa, passing through Asolo, where this famous climb begins. Majestic panorama from the top over the entire Venetian plain and on the ridges where bloody battles of the Great War took place. We return stopping in Bassano del Grappa, where a vehicle gathers us to return to the hotel.

Tuesday - smaller islands of Venice

A boat trip not to weigh down your legs in view of the Dolomites. We disembark in Murano to visit the ovens of artistic glass processing, a pleasant refreshment in Burano, with a visit to the lace museum, and a historical visit to Torcello. Returning to the departure, a vehicle will take us to Alleghe in a couple of hours, while your luggage and your bicycles will have already arrived at their destination.

<u>Montegrappa</u>

A terrace on the plain located more than 1700m above the sea, the scene of war clashes of the great war, enjoys a unique panorama.

Isole di Venezia

They are also named "gardens of Venice" for the horticultural tradition known since the times of the Republic of Venice.

They are the historic home of handmade glass and lace productions



<u>Tuesday - short holiday starts</u>

For those who start their short week holiday, a meeting point for Treviso airport (TSF) or Venice airport (VCE) if you arrive by flight. If you arrive with your car meeting point at the hotel.

Wednesday – Marmolada

Are you starting to get serious? We have the freedom to choose between two itineraries concerning the Queen of the Dolomites. The gentle and panoramic Campolongo Pass, returning to Val Badia, the Valparola and Farzarego passes, in the footsteps of the Great War, or the terrible Fedaia and Pordoi in succession for a respectable dolomite stages.

Marmolada

It is a diamond set between the walls of the heart of the Dolomites, a glacier visible from afar, reachable by cable car.

Until a year ago, people used to pass through the suggestive "serrai di sottoguda", now closed due to the Vaia storm.



Thursday - Pearl of the Dolomites

Parade in "Corso Italia", central street in Cortina d'Ampezzo.

We start from the hotel to immediately climb the Giau Pass, which from this side is fearful in terms of length and slope. After the usual photos on the pass, a pleasant descent to Cortina d'Ampezzo awaits us for a refreshment in the city center of the 2021 World Cup and the 2026 Olympics with Milan. We set off again on a leg-loosening path, slightly downhill which leads us to Belluno, whose historic center welcomes us in its medieval beauty. A vehicle takes us back to Treviso.

Friday - Islands of Venice

Leg lover with a day dedicated to off road and seafood food and wine specialties. Short transfer to Venice and with the fatbikes we will cross the bridge that leads to the historic city. A ferry boat will take us to the Lido Island, where a mix of elegance and history brings us to the laurels and dawns of Venice at the beginning of the last century.



Cortina d'Ampezzo

The "Pearl of the Dolomites", already home to the winter Olympics games, repeats with the World Ski Championships in 2021 and the Winter Olympics in 2026. Corso Italia is the mundane center of the city where a walkway is a must.

<u>Lido di Venezia</u>

Luchino Visconti in "death in Venice" movie, well represented the atmosphere and splendor of the early 1900s.

The cinema exhibition and the Excelsior hotel are the mundane emblem of Venice



We will travel stretches of beach and the natural sand dunes that are on this island. A tasty refreshment on the beach and a visit to Pellestrina, an ancient and characteristic seaside resort. Return to the hotel in Treviso with a short transfer.

Saturday - Palladio between architecture and agriculture

A sporting, cultural and food and wine excursion on the Berici hills, from Vicenza to Montagnana and back in a hilly ups and downs among olive trees, vineyards, Venetian villas and cave houses. A pleasant tasting of oils, wines as a half-day refreshment and unique panoramas of Palladian art. Return to the hotel in Treviso and farewell gala dinner

Sunday – Leave

Breakfast and then free Transfer possible at the airport



Pellestrina

Totally marine island, whose ancient architecture and traditions are evident in the landscape. Tradition and history enclosed in about 10K of island.

Architettura Vicentina

Architecture not only Palladian, also rock, peasant and rural is found on the Berici Hills of Vicenza.

Oil and wine are the purpose of these panoramic hills.

Booking

Travel contract

With this you will be given all the references of the hotel, telephone of the members of the organization who will follow you on your holiday and anything else requested and agreed upon. You will also be given a copy of the travel insurance and "fun experience travel agency" guarantee.

<u>Cancellation policy</u> Until 12.00 (Italian time) on the 30th day before the departure of the holiday, it can be canceled without any penalty and the amount will be refunded after deducting the bank transfer costs and the deposit.

From 12.00 (Italian time) on the 30th day to 12.00 (Italian time) on the 10th day before the departure of the holiday in case of cancellation or modification of the travel contract, a penalty of 50% of the price will be applied and the remaining amount is returned, less bank transfer fees.

From 12.00 (Italian time) on the 10th day in case of cancellation the penalty is 100%.


